Jorge Alfredo Ramirez passed away at the age of 40 in San Diego, California on October 30th, 2018. He was born in San Diego on January 23rd, 1978 to Asencion Ramirez and Maria Magana. Jorge was the second son of four wonderful sons. He also had a loving step-father, Refugio Flores. He attended Hoover high school and the University Technical Institute (UTI), where he earned an Associates degree in automotive diesel. Jorge served his country 8 years in the U.S. Navy.
