She attended and graduated from Phyllis Wheatley High School in Houston, TX and shortly after, married Earnest F. Payton. This union yielded two daughters, Sheila and Sharon. Later in life, a union in marriage to James H. Robinson, II blessed Faye with two more children, Stephanie and James III, affectionately known as Jimmy. As a military spouse to James II, Faye was a devoted homemaker while the military moved them all over the western United States, to include California and Oregon, and overseas, to include Japan and Hawaii, before retirement led her family to settle in San Diego. Perhaps, the task Faye was most devoted to was being a doting grandmother to 8 and great-grandmother to 5 great grandchildren whom she cared for and adored.
