Maria Clara “Ynday” Bagares peacefully passed away surrounded by her family on Friday, October 14, 2016, at Magnolia Post Acute Care in El Cajon, California. She was 93 years old. Maria was born on May 19, 1923 in Sogod, Southern Leyte, Philippines to Gregorio Palco Bagares and Manuela Rodriguez Monte de Ramos. Her siblings were Jesus Gregorio, Roberto Pio, Simeona Maximina, Pantaleon Yates, Deterlino Bianco, Divina Deodima, Cecilia Priscila, Francisco Franco, Benito Mussolini, Rebecca Germana, and Ligaya Grema.
