He went on to attend the University of California at San Diego and graduated with honors earning a Bachelors of Arts in English Literature, and a Masters of Business Administration in Management Science. This led to Sherwin's career as an accomplished executive with the title of Human Resources Director and Vice-President of several businesses. He later met the love of his life, Patricia Montano, and they were joined in holy matrimony on July 22, 2000. Soon they moved into a lovely loft home near Little Italy with beautiful views of San Diego Bay. There they enjoyed the urban lifestyle that living downtown would afford them.
