Nicho died with the firm hope of being united with his loved ones in the resurrection and live forever in a paradise on earth.

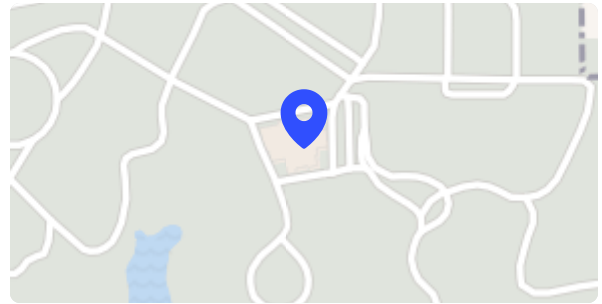

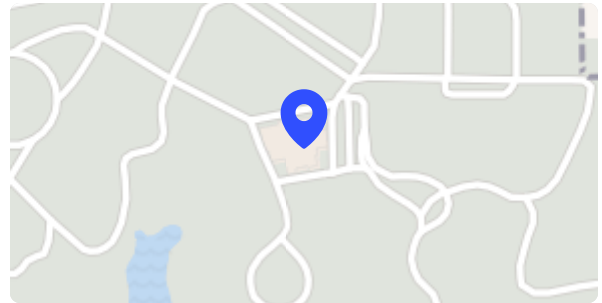
