Jeanne is survived by her brothers; William Robert Woody and Phillip Woody along with a host of family and friends.






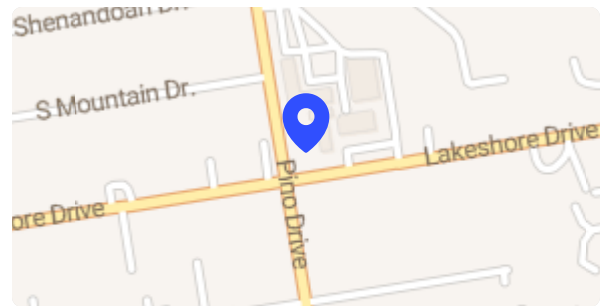

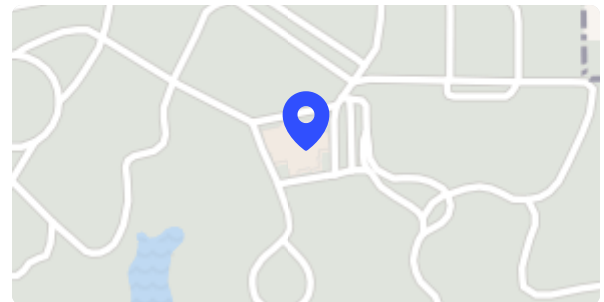

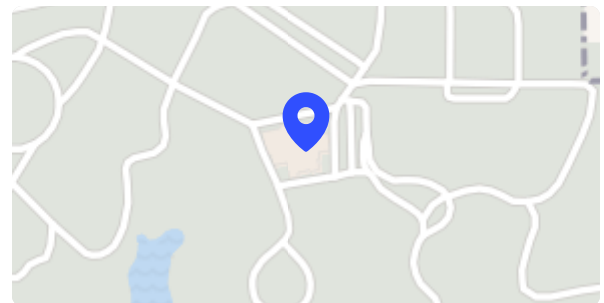
