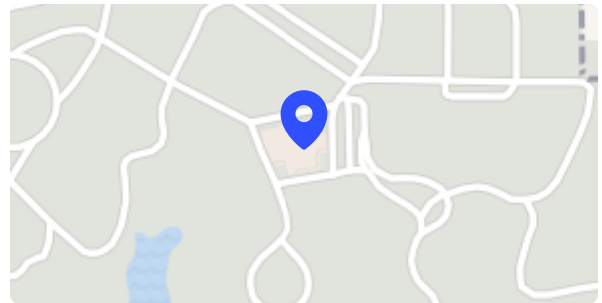

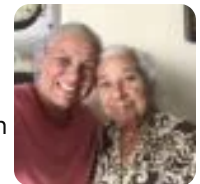

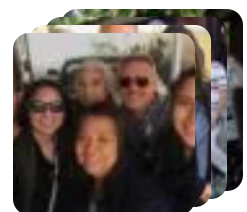
Santos posted:

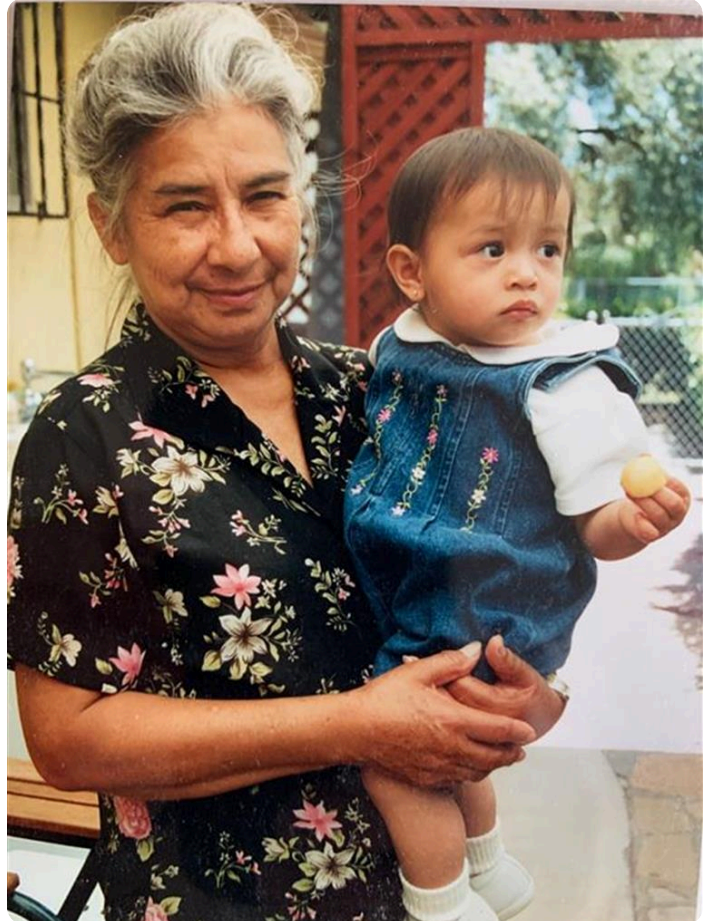
