One of his favorite hobbies of all time was to take pictures and have his camera rolling at all times to capture every special moment he could, so he can watch those memories captured later. During family gatherings or any special occasion, everyone knew to wave at the camera because there was Jose with his camcorder. Jose had a thing for music no matter what it was. His favorite music was mostly oldies and old rock and roll. When ever he had a song he loved come out on the radio, he used the dash board of the car as drums and sing to the song that was being played on the radio. 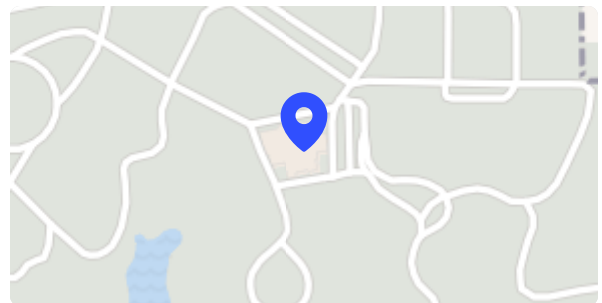
