**L**eticia Dominguez Campaña Aug. 24, 1939 – Jun. 7, 2021, Devoted wife of the late Teofilo Campaña, beloved mother, grandmother, sister, minister of God, and friend to many, peacefully joined our Dear Lord on June 7, 2021. She was 81 years old.
