Unfortunately he did not make it in the ambulance ride from the airplane to the hospital. He leaves behind his two beloved parents, 4 brothers, 2 sisters, his wife and the many people who were rooting him on in his last few months of his fight. 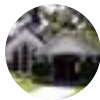

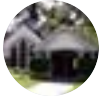

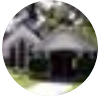
