Antonio “Tony” Román, National City, California, passed away on November 4, 2021, at the age of 73. Tony died peacefully with his beloved wife, their children and grandchildren by his side.

Tony was born in Durango México on June 7th, 1948, to father Juan Román and mother Dolores Márquez. The second eldest son of eight children, Tony didn't have the opportunity for much formal education. He helped out his family and worked as a butcher at an early age. His work ethic and desire to take care of his family led him to the United States in 1971.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Alicia; daughter Thelma, sons Marco and wife Joyce; Johnny and wife Marisa; grandchildren Esteban, Christian, Johnny, Isabella, Joaquín, Emma, Avery and Jacob; siblings Carmela, Miguel and Federico.
