Después del fallecimiento de su Sr padre, Manuel se unió al movimiento de jornaleros de zacatecas, aun siendo menor de edad. Traslándose a los estados unidos. Después se reunion con su Sra Madre eh hermanos en la ciudad de Tijuana Baja California Mexico. Donde conoció a su futura esposa Trinidad Fonseca de Bañuelos. Su matrimonio permaneció por mas de 53 años donde tuvieron 7 hijos mas de 20 Nietos, 19 bisnietos y 6 tataranietos.

Juan Manuel fue un exitoso comerciante, fundador del Mercado Cali-Mex, donde estableció sucursales de San Ysidro CA hasta en la ciudad de Los Angeles CA.

Al principio de los 80's inauguro el Lienzo Charro San Geronimo que fue la casa de los Charros de San Ysidro y la escaramuza Las Golondrinas. Fue lugar donde se ejecutaron charreadas con equipos de toda la república Mexicana, como tambien el congreso charro Estatal y Nacional de Charros de Estados Unidos. Con mucho orgullo mantuvo el famoso toro "El Canicas" al cual quedo invicto (no se le quedo ningún jinete) en El lienzo charro San Geronimo.

Tanto su Esposa Trinidad Fonseca de Bañuelos, su hija Lucina Bañuelos de Medina, Hermanos Jesuita, Amparo, Beatriz, Geronimo y Alfredo Fallecieron antes que Juan Manuel.

Juan Manuel Bañuelos Ortiz was born on December 13, 1932 in Morelos, Zacatecas. He was one of 8 born to Geronimo Bañuelos and Maria G. Ortiz de Bañuelos.

As a minor, Manuel joined the movement of labor workers of Zacatecas, MX and worked in the United States. After, he reunited with his mother and siblings in Tijuana, Mexico. There he met his future wife, Trinidad Fonseca de Bañuelos. They were married for 53 years and had 7 children, over 20 grand children, 19 great grandchildren and 6 great great grandchildren.

Juan Manuel was a great entrepreneur. He owned and operated Cali-Mex Meat Market and had locations from San Ysidro all the way to the Los Angeles area.

In the early 80's, he inaugurated el Lienzo Charro de San Geronimo that was home to Los Charros de San Ysidro and the Escaramuza Las Golondrinas. Charros from all over Mexico and United States participated in charreadas that were held there until the late 1990's. He took great pride that his bull, El Canicas, was one of the toughest and not one Charro was able to stay on long enough to brag about it.

Juan Manuel is pre-deceased by his wife, Trinidad Fonseca de Bañuelos, his daughter Lucina Bañuelos de Medina and his siblings Jesusita, Amparo, Beatriz, Geronimo and Alfredo.

He is survived by his siblings Sergio and Jaime Bañuelos,

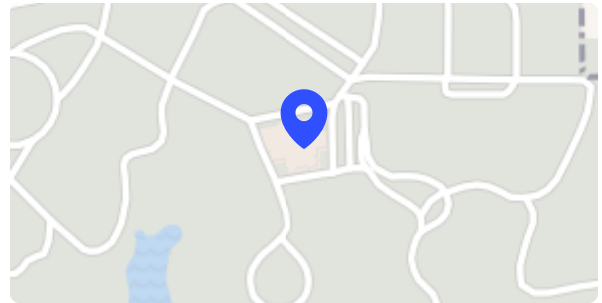
