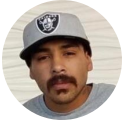
Leobardo Samuel Garcia, 31, passed away August 11th, 2023.

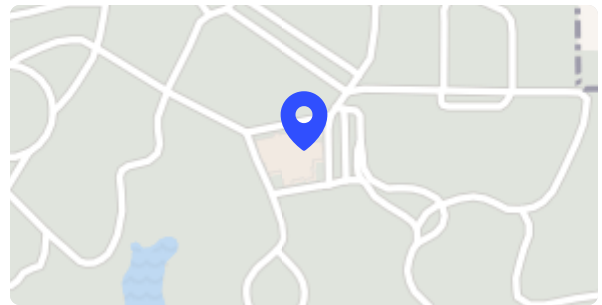


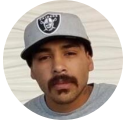

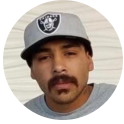
