He went to Lanier High School and proceeded to enlist in the United States Navy in 1952. In 1956, Ardy met the love of his life Ms. Ruby Lee Calhoun. They were married soon after in Yuma, AZ. in 1957. They spent the early years of their marriage living in the Philippines and from their union came two children: Ardy D. Chadwick and Anthony L Chadwick.

Ardy served his country courageously for 30 years and retired as a Chief Petty Officer. He then began a successful second career as an entrepreneur and created a janitorial business he named Chadwick & Sons Janitorial. Ardy loved hunting, camping, and fishing.
