**R**uby Earl Timms, 98, cherished mom, grandmother, wife and sister, passed away on July 5th, 2025.

Born on December 19th, 1926, in Ashland, TX (now known as Diana), Ruby was the oldest of eight children. Ruby came to California and settled in San Diego so long ago, she liked to say, "it was before the bridge (Coronado) was built". She worked as an Aircraft Metal Worker on North Island for many years where she met a freckle faced boy named Vester.

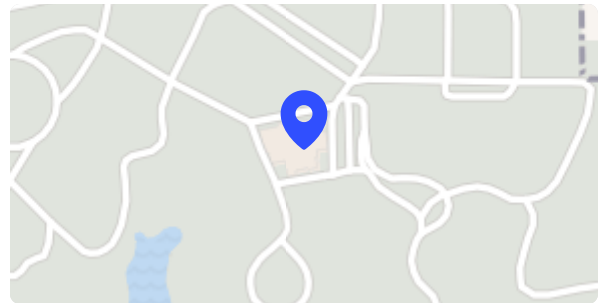
