Nicholas James Kromydas passed away October 16, 2025, at home with his family.

He was a '68 graduate of Hilltop High School before going on to graduate from Cal Poly Pomona in '74 with a degree in Architecture.

After traveling the world, he settled into the Lake Tahoe area. In 1978, he married and shortly after received his Architect's license. 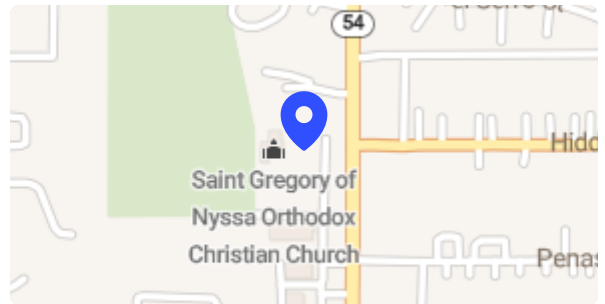
