Above all, Dennis cherished his family. He leaves behind his loving son, Dustin Michael Knapp, who will carry forward his father's legacy of generosity and strength.

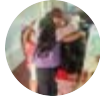
Dennis will be remembered as a man of integrity, compassion, and selflessness. His memory will live on in the hearts of all who knew him.

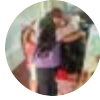
